SCRIPTURE & DISCUSSION

- 1. Bible teachers say that there are four movements in the grand story of the Bible: Creation, Fall, Redemption and Restoration. Describe them in your own words.
- 2. Read John 1:14 and Rev. 21:3. What can you discern about God's heart from these verses? What does this mean for our relationship with him now?
- 3. Read John 17:3 and Phil. 3:7–8. In both of these passages, the word know is the Greek word metaknosis which is not a mind knowledge but a deep relational knowledge (e.g. Adam knew Eve and that resulted in a child). Knowing that, what insights do you have from these verses?
