SCRIPTURE & DISCUSSION

1. Comment on Dave's logic: you have to believe in the death and resurrection of Jesus to be a Christian; the only place you know about Jesus' death and resurrection is the Bible; therefore, Christians should believe the Bible.
2. If we know that God raised Jesus from the dead, why do some Christians have problems with miracles in the Bible?
3. **Read 2 Timothy 2:14–18.**
This is a letter to a young pastor. In your own words, what is Paul telling him he must do? What does it say false teaching will do?
4. What values do we bring to the Bible, instead of letting the Bible change our values?
