### SCRIPTURE & DISCUSSION

#### 1. Read Romans 8:22–23.

- » What are we supposed to be longing for? What does that tell you about the life we find ourselves in now?
- » We know that we have the Holy Spirit as a foretaste of heaven; what does that tell us about *now*?
- » After listening to the message, why shouldn't we blame God for our suffering?

#### 2. Read Genesis 3:1–5.

- » What were Satan's temptations (in your own words)?
- » Why is it so difficult to trust God?
- » Discuss why / how we can know that God loves us.

### PRAY WITH US

- Praise for those on their way to God who have been participating in our online services. Pray that we will continue to be good stewards of new opportunities to reach out online.
- Praise for those who have signed up to participate in our Adopt a Student program. Ask that the Holy Spirit will be helping to build connections between students and supporters that will have a long-term impact and that students will experience the Church as a body of believers who care for them.
- Pray for participants on their way to God as well as people interested in serving on our Alpha team as we consider an online Alpha outreach this semester.
- Please ask God to intervene in our work with the City of Hamilton so that our final Site Plan Approval can be completed.

### PRACTICAL CHALLENGE
